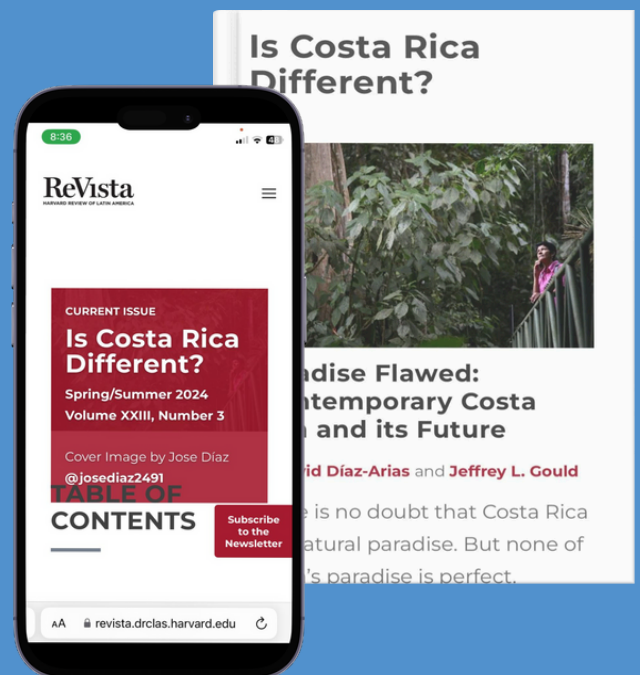
In commemoration of World Press Freedom Day, we developed a joint campaign with press and organizations
