






#### History



- Heavy Transportation Company








#### **Egyptian Contribution to International Peace and Security**

#### **Egyptian Women In Peace Keeping Forces**

The Security Council adopted Resolution (S/RES/1325) on women, peace and security on 31 October 2000. The resolution reaffirms the important role of women in the prevention and resolution of conflicts, peace negotiations, peace-building, peacekeeping, humanitarian response and in post-conflict reconstruction and stresses the importance of their equal participation and full involvement in all efforts for the maintenance and promotion of peace and security.








#### **National Action Plan**

#### **Involvement Since 2017**

Women's participation began in 2017 with female officer in UN missions, notably in the Central African Republic.

#### **Focus on Training**

The Armed Forces prioritize training women in peace and security, enhancing their roles in international missions and leadership positions.

Women make up 26.67% of Egypt's contributions to UN peace operations as observers and leaders.
