PAKISTANI WOMEN IN MILITARY

- In 1948, formation of women's unit in Pakistan Army Medical Corps
- Pakistan Army introduced lady cadet course in 2006 commissioned in April 2007
- Till 2024, 23 x lady course batches have been commissioned in Ord, EME, RVF&C, ASC, AEC, Signals, JAG Branch
- Since 2019, Lady Officers start serving in UN / foreign assignments

PAKISTANI WOMEN IN PEACE OPERATIONS

- Currently Pakistan is 5th largest TCC
- 3505 x peacekeepers are serving in 8 x UN missions
- 148 x female peacekeepers are included in overall strength deployed in 7x UN Missions
- Since 2017, over 450 x
 Pakistani female
 peacekeepers have served
 under UN flag
- 150% increase in number of female officers receiving military training in US

CHALLENGES FOR WOMEN

- Family management issues because of frequent postings / foreign assignments
- Military readiness reduced during pregnancies
- Social and cultural norms vs on duty requirements
- Gender preferences / unequal pay
- Gender based violence

BEST PRACTICES ON WOMEN WORKING IN MILITARY TO

SOLDIERS

COUNTER SEXUAL HARASSMENT / ABUSE

BEST PRACTICES - INITIAL DEPLOYMENT / LADY OFFICERS

- Women are inducted only in officer ranks after graduation / Masters /PHDs
- Initially employed on their family stations / nearer to family stations
- Lady officers posted in group of two or more incase of other than family station deployment
- Lady officers are posted to static Installations only. On later stages, deployed in units nearer to spouse / family stations
- It is preferred, no single Lady employed on field duties rather in groups
- Special arrangements to be made in order to provide privacy and comfortable working environment
- Strict standard operating procedures followed and circulated to all on routine basis



BOAS PRATICAS – ALOCAMENTO INICAL / OFICIAIS MULHERES



BEST PRACTICES - FOREIGN DEPLOYMENT / LADY OFFICERS

- UN human rights / charter of duties strictly followed and implemented
- Lady officers in higher ranks / after gaining experience are detailed for foreign assignments
- Officers irrespective of gender to intimate reporting channel their whereabouts for any duty / foreign assignments / visits
- Special briefings are mandatory to attend by male / female officers for any foreign assignments to ensure their security protocols
- Officers to report GHQ / sponsors after completion of foreign assignment for debrief
- Proper dress code to be followed after working hours besides uniform in working hours
- Strict disciplinary actions by PS Dte in case of

any failures

BEST PRACTICES - LADIES DEPLOYEMENT LOWER RANKS

- Women inducted in lower ranks as nurses, helpers, civilian staff to be served under lady supervision
- Leaves, duties, to be managed by lady supervisor resulting less vulnerable to be exploited by male supervisors
- Extra working hours / late hour sittings discouraged
- Separate rest rooms, messing areas ensured for ladies
- Strict standard operating procedures followed and circulated to all as routine basis
- In case of field duties, ladies deployed in groups, preferably under supervision of ladies
- Proper dress code to be followed during working hours / deployment
